



Expectations for Study Hall

*New changes to our study hall policy this year!

I WOULD SAY THAT UNSATISFACTORY GRADES WOULD BE MY NUMBER ONE CONCERN FOR OUR WRESTLERS. PLEASE HELP TO MAKE SURE THAT ALL WRESTLERS ARE ELLIGIBLE AND WORKING HARD IN THE CLASSROOM SO THAT WE ARE IN GOOD ACADEMIC STANDING AND EVERYONE IS ELIGIBILE FOR COMPETITIONS.

1. All wrestlers will be required to do grade checks.
2. Wrestlers with unsatisfactory grades will have to do weekly grade checks due every Friday.
3. If a wrestler has below a 2.0GPA or has any D's or F's when they turn in grade checks then they are required to do grade checks weekly until their grades improve.
4. Wrestlers who have satisfactory grades have free time until practice starts at 3:30. They can visit teachers for help, do their homework in a place of their choice, go to the weight room, or just relax.
5. *Wrestlers who aren't meeting standards or don't turn in completed grade checks on time must attend study hall. They will receive a study hall signature sheet from Coach Reinholt. They will need to check in with the teacher of the class that they have a D or F in by 2:40pm (NO LATER) for help/complete make-up work/retake tests. This process will happen every day until that specific grade has improved to a C or higher. Wrestlers can do homework/get teacher help until practice starts at 3:30 (students can check out from teacher at 3:20). The coaching staff will also call home/email to report grade problems/ incomplete or missing grade checks.
6. New grade checks will determine the wrestlers who have to attend the mandatory study hall.
7. Failure to follow these expectations will result in owing time at practice, not being able to practice, not being able to compete, and/or being removed from the team.
8. We hope that **ALL** students will take advantage of this great opportunity so they will have homework completed or questions answered before they even go to practice. Wrestlers need to use extended period time which allows all of our kids 45 minutes of homework/help/make-up time per day plus an additional 50 minutes of study time available after school (That's over an hour and a half of study time per day before practice starts). This is also an excellent time to do retakes and make up any work in all classes for all wrestlers.
